TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

When I decided this year to visit Rajneeshpuram and Bhagwan, again, many people asked me what was so special about Bhagwan and his religion. I think that being part of a religion is good, but being part of a religion that is grouped round a living master is something different: religion is happening here, it is so alive, growing. Come and have a taste of it! It will change you too. Why chase somebody away who only is teaching God is silence; all mystics did, because God is not explicable in words.
