I have an honors degree in Mathematics & Physics (BSc - Queen's University, Kingston Ontario - 1968) & would like to testify to the great contributions Bhagwan Shree Rajneesh has made in these fields, especially Math. Math has been generally considered an exact & impeccable field, a hard science, a tool for engineers & economists, which is all right as far as it goes.
