## TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

For the past twelve years I have worked as a record producer in many countries around the world with considerable success. I have produced records for large and small companies and have worked and recorded all types of music including classical music, rock music and music for films. In Norway I received the Spellmann Award for Service to the Arts in combining modern pop music with traditional folk songs; I have also been awarded several gold and silver discs from different countries in recognition of high record sales.

Four years ago I made my first contact with Bhagwan Shree Rajneesh when I was working in Germany with some highly professional musicians who were also his followers. I have since worked with other musicians who are also Rajneeshees and have never failed to be impressed by their light relaxed spirit and the ease, enjoyment and efficiency with which they work. Through his teachings, I have somehow managed to find a 'religious' dimension in my work as a record producer and this has improved its quality and given me a greater job fulfilment.

In this day and age the teachings of Bhagwan Shree Rajneesh are a positive and much-needed contribution to the health of mankind.
