To Whom It May Concern:

I wish to attest to the exceptional abilities of Bhagwan Shree Rajneesh and to the contribution that his teachings and presence provide to me and to the entire community of Rajneeshpuram.

I am the Director of Community Development for the City of Rajneeshpuram. I graduated from Harvard University in 1973 with a Master's degree in Planning. I have worked as a planner for the cities of San Mateo and San Luis Obispo in California before coming to Rajneeshpuram.
