I am living and working as a computer scientist in Germany. My study at the University of Bonn ended with a diploma in informatics and logic. After this I worked as a systems analysist in several computer companies in the area of microprosessor development, real time processing and video systems software. Now I am 30 years old.

During my study I did research in the field of the foundations of sciences, which led me to the origin of modern axiomatic mathematics and the history of natural sciences. I studied philosophers like Bertrand Russell, Ludwig Wittgenstein as well as authorities of the modern cybernetics (Wiener. Shannon, Chomsky) to find out the basic ideas about information. verification, data and language.

The simple conclusion of this work was the realisation that there was a fundamental subject-object-dichotomy in western science which left the field of the research of inner psychic evidence - that is, where and under which conditions informations are we verified and data processed - to psychology and medicine.
