Among other subjects I teach religious education. Three years ago I started to read books by Bhagwan Shree Rajneesh, especially the ones about Jesus, which to me opened a new outlook on Christ and Christianity and which brought Jesus nearer to me than many sermons at chuich, lessons at school or books I read.

Bhagwan has spoken more than 100 books about many different subjects. Now he has has stopped to give lectures and has started to work through silence. Is that the reason why you can+t look at him as a spiritual master? Don't you know about the constructive and healing power of silence?

Why don't you give him and the place which he is bilding up with his Sannyasins a chance? Auroville in India, which was created by Sri Aurobindo was and still is such an experiment of people trying to live their love. Why can't you tolerate an experiment like Rajneeshtown in Oregon?
