## TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

I am a librarian and studied librarianship from 1979 to 1982 at the Frederik Muller Academy in Amsterdam. Last year I have worked at the Public Library of Amsterdam.

A library, just like many other governmental bodies, is a mass institute, where the relationship between librarian and client is usually very impersonal.
