I'd like to share with you my experience of Bhagwan Shree Rajneesh.

For fifteen years I studied consciousness and religion, trying to understand myself and the people around me and the world we live in. I read hundreds of books written by the great men and women of our time and past times.

I lived with American Indians learning of nature and the Great Spirit. I lived with Buddhists and I lived with Christians. From these people I learned meditations and methods that helped to still the mind and open the heart. By and by I felt a presence growing within and around me.

In the spring of 1981, I met some sannyasin (disciples of Bhagwan) and very quickly recognizing the presence I'd been feeling was Bhagwan. I

became a sannyasin too and in time I came to Rajneeshpuram. Words cannot describe the feelings on that first day here, the first time I saw Him drive by. Since then I have sat with Him in satsangs and darshans, seen Him drive by each day.
