I am 37 years old and a computer analyst. Originally I had learned the profession of a typograph. After military service I did a $2\frac{1}{2}$ year evening course to attain my A-degree. After 2 years studying law at Vienna university I started work as a computer operator.

During all this time I was looking for something I did not really know what it was. My life was unhappy and I struggled really hard to attain what I thought would be a life worth living.

My philosophy was left-winged and my thinking quite radical. After a few years I climbed the ladder and became a programmer.

I participated in several human growth programs and I was quite successful in the left movement in Austria but still unhappy because I felt it was not right to blame others for my own unhappiness. I became an analyst by this time, earned quite a lot of money, gained more personal power but nothing really changed.

Then, about five years ago, I happened to get a book on answers Bhagwan (I did not hear about this man before) gave to his disciples who were with him in Poona / India.

I can say this book really changed my life.

It is hard to describe what was happening as I read it.

A clarity rose that was so beautiful it was breathtaking.

There was and is a man who clearly speaks out everyone's hidden thoughts. Getting more and more into it what has been happening I have become more and more secure and also aware about my hidden thoughts and feelings.

My life has become more and more happy, clear and fulfilled.

I consider this man to be my master and I really want him to live in this country of freedom and human rights. Rajneeshpuram, the city where he is living now as a visitor, is the most breathtaking commune-experiment I know.

Bhagwan is the inspiration for all the people there and gives them courage to try nearly "impossible" things.

There is no crime in this city, no violence, no child-abuse, no rape. Work is not a four-letter word, it is simply meditation and joy. I have never seen such a creativity and have never felt so much caring love than in this commune.

The "bhuddafield", created by this incredible man needs to stay.

In this commune a new deep religiosity is growing which, with all effects on the way of living, could be a model for all communities in America. Bhagwan is their religious leader. Without him it would not be possible. He should become a permanent resident in the USA.
