In 1972, I have finished my studies of psychology ('67-'72) at the Catholic University of Louvain. I was 22 years old. Then I have worked for six years ('72-'78), as assistant at this university at the department of "Orthopaedagogie". I was giving practica of "Special learning disabilities" and "Testing of handicapped children".

Also I have followed a course of self-training in the Human Relation Centre, at Louvain ('79-'81)

Now, I am working ('78-'83) as teacher, giving "Didactic", to girls of 18-20 years (becoming also a teacher).

During all these years, I was searching for real values of life. My studies, training and work, were giving me a partial answer about that.

In 1980 I was meeting a friend, who has visited a living, inspired man, in India (Poona), talking about things of live: Bhagwan Shree Rajwesh. He was a previous professor of philosophie.
